He was awarded an MBE in 2009 for his services to policing. Gary has lectured internationally to police and academic institutions, and became the National Investigative Interviewing Adviser within the National Crime Agency (NCA). During this time, Gary supported police services throughout the UK with their investigations into serious, complex and major crime, developing implementation plans around the National Interview Strategy, and developing training on the interviewing of significant witnesses and suspects.

In this Masterclass, Gary will share practical tips on how to conduct an effective investigative interview, focusing on workplace investigations, bringing insights (and stories) from his colourful career.
